Why is solar energy booming in El Salvador?

In recent years, solar PV, wind and as well as other renewable technologies have boomed in El Salvador as the country looks to move away from traditional energy sources seen as compromising the country's socioeconomic future.

How much solar power does El Salvador have?

From pv magazine LatAm El Salvador's energy regular, SIGET, said this week that the country's total installed PV capacity reached 633 MW by the end of 2023. The nation's total installed power generation capacity now stands at 2.99 GW, with 638 MW from hydropower. Solar accounts for about 21.1% of the nation's electricity mix.

Can solar power help people living in poverty in El Salvador?

Continuing to replace biomass with cleaner, safer alternatives will improve the lives of those living in poverty in El Salvador. 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Towards sustainable energy, El Salvador is set to embrace a future dominated by renewable projects, contributing to the region's ambitious target of 95% renewable energy by 2024. 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CEL contributes 32.3% of El Salvador's electricity generation and 48.7% of its renewable energy resources. As of 2020, El Salvador's total installed electrical capacity was 2360 MW, fueled by a mix of fossil fuels (32.67%), hydro (24.31%), solar (20.10%), biomass (12.44%), geothermal (8.66%), wind (1.53%) and biogas (0.29%).

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El Salvador's energy sector is largely focused on renewables. El Salvador is the largest producer of geothermal energy in Central America. Except for hydroelectric generation, which is almost totally owned and operated by the public company CEL (Comisión Hidroeléctrica del Río Lempa), the rest of the generation capacity is in private hands.
