

Norfolk Island is a tiny island (3,455 hectares) in the South Pacific Ocean. While an Australian Territory, it's much closer to the Kiwis than us - approximately 1,400 kilometres directly east of Evans Head in NSW compared to around 760 kilometres from NZ's Cape Reinga.

On Norfolk Island electricity is still largely generated by diesel generators. The tariff for this source of energy is 82 cents/kWh from 1 July 2024. However, the diesel generators can be turned off when sufficient energy is stored in the central battery to provide a needed buffer.

2015. ABSTRACT. Norfolk Island, on the northeast edge of the Tasman Sea, is of volcanic origin and moderate height. A humid, forested subtropical landmass, it had a diverse range of natural resources, including some food plants such as Cyathea, forest birds such as pigeon and parrot species and substantial colonies of seabirds, notably boobies and procellariids.
