Are solar panels a viable source of electricity in Eswatini?

Photovoltaic (PV) solar cells are increasingly prominent sources of small-scale electricity production in Eswatini. The government actively encourages the adoption of solar panels in residential and commercial buildings to provide both electricity and water heating.

Hydroelectric power currently stands as one of the most prominent energy sources in Eswatini. The EEC operates four hydropower plants, constituting 15% of the country's electricity production and plans to bolster the existing infrastructure.

By investing in renewable energy and expanding electric connectivity, the government aims to liberate unelectrified Swazi citizens from the energy poverty trap, enabling them to realize their untapped potential. These are the four key sectors of renewable energy in Eswatini that are receiving strategic government investments and support.

MBABANE - With the increasing demand for electricity, there is a significant opportunity for the further expansion of solar power in Eswatini, especially in the industrial and agricultural sectors. Eswatini's maximum local electricity demand was recorded to be 245.17 megawatts(MW) in 2020 and is expected to grow to 334MW by 2035.

The International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA) estimates Eswatini's theoretical and technical hydropower potential at 440 MW and 110 MW, respectively, while utility-scale solar potential is 542 MW.
