The Lomé-based African Biofuel & Renewable Energy Company (Abrec) has awarded a contract to Sinohydro to build a 20MWp solar plant at Gardete, 8km from Bissau, as well as a 30kV connection to the B&#244;r substation. Abrec said six eligible bids were received in an international tender that closed in May last year. Work is expected to take 16 months.

The World Bank is supporting the development of Guinea-Bissau's first solar power plants, aiming to decarbonise electricity production and boost electrification. Under the Solar Energy and Access to Electricity Development Project, the World Bank will assist Guinea-Bissau until 2030 and has already approved a USD \$30 million grant.
