

# How to calculate the price of photovoltaic panels installed on the floor

To calculate the return on investment (ROI) for your solar panel installation, you need to consider the total cost of the installation and estimate your annual savings on energy bills. Start by adding up all the expenses associated with purchasing and installing the solar panels.

To calculate the KWp (kilowatt-peak) of a solar panel system, you need to determine the total solar panel area and the solar panel yield, expressed as a percentage. Here are the steps involved in this calculation:

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Measuring the available roof space is a crucial step in determining the potential capacity of your PV system. Begin by measuring the unshaded area on your roof where solar panels can be installed effectively. Unlike other regions, Sri Lanka, located close to the equator, enjoys efficient solar energy generation regardless of the panel direction.

The first factor in calculating solar panel output is the power rating. There are mainly 3 different classes of solar panels: Small solar panels: 50W and 100W panels. Standard solar panels: 200W, 250W, 300W, 350W, 500W panels. There are a lot of in-between power ratings like 265W, for example. Big solar panel system: 1kW, 4kW, 5kW, 10kW system ...

Today's premium monocrystalline solar panels typically cost between \$1 and \$1.50 per Watt, putting the price of a single 400-watt solar panel between \$400 and \$600, depending on how you buy it. Less efficient polycrystalline panels are typically cheaper at \$0.75 per watt, putting the price of a 400-watt panel at \$300.

$r$  is the yield of the solar panel given by the ratio : electrical power (in kWp) of one solar panel divided by the area of one panel. Example : the solar panel yield of a PV module of 250 Wp with an area of 1.6 m<sup>2</sup> is 15.6%. Be aware that this nominal ratio is given for standard test conditions (STC) : radiation=1000 W/m<sup>2</sup>, cell temperature=25 celcius degree, Wind speed=1 m/s, AM=1.5.

Suppose, in our case the load is 3000 Wh/per day. To know the needed total W Peak of a solar panel capacity, we use PFG factor i.e. Total W Peak of PV panel capacity = 3000 / 3.2 (PFG) = 931 W Peak. Now, the required number of PV panels are = 931 / 160W = 5.8. This way, we need 6 numbers of solar panels each

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rated for 160W.

Lastly, Divide the Total Size of the Solar Project (in kW) derived in the above step by the Total Size of 1 Solar Panel, and you'll get the Total Number of Solar Panels (in Nos.) Required. Generally, the Total Size of 1 Solar Panel is 330 Watts or 0.33 kW.
