Are data centers consuming too much energy in Ireland?

Ireland embraced data centers that the AI boom needs. Now they're consuming too much of its energy. CLONDALKIN, Ireland (AP) -- Dozens of massive data centers humming at the outskirts of Dublin are consuming more electricity than all of the urban homes in Ireland and starting to wear out the warm welcome that brought them here.

Does Ireland still have a peat-fired power plant?

Why does Ireland need gas?

After oil, gas is Ireland's second most prominent energy source. Gas makes up almost half of our electricity generation and will be required for many years to supply flexibility as renewable generation grows. We are highly dependent on imported gas, which leaves us exposed to growing geopolitical tensions and shifts in the global power balance.

How much biomethane will Ireland produce by 2030?

Growing development of biomethane and early hydrogen projects Ireland is currently developing a National Biomethane Strategy that aims to produce 5.7 TWh of biomethane by 2030. Carbon Capture and Storage

Why is Ireland halting new data centers near Dublin until 2028?

Fears of rolling blackouts led Ireland's grid operator to halt new data centers near Dublin until 2028.
