Does Norfolk Island have too much solar energy?

That's pretty impressive given its remoteness and a population of 1,849. But this uptake has also caused some headaches in managing Norfolk Island's electricity network, with too much solar energy goodness generated at times. This month, on average, solar systems installed on Norfolk Island produced 2.9kWh of energy per kW

installed. Back in January, this average was 4.0kWh per kW. Current production is approximately 30% lower. With less solar production we are unable to turn off the diesel generators for as long each day.
