Install the combiner box's support braces on the same horizontal plane to prevent long-term deformation. Use M17/304 stainless steel screws for secure wall-piece installation. Installation should facilitate easy door opening and closing for maintenance. Note: Moisture during installation can damage the combiner box.

A PV panel for a solar lighting system differs from the traditional large solar panel, since it comprises four solar cells. PV panel consist of solar cells connected in series to produce a higher voltage. A single solar cell converts sunlight into electricity by generating current, which is called "photovoltaic effect".

The ideal pitch for a Solar Panel is around 30 degrees off the horizontal. Simply because this allows the panels to gain more exposure from the sun throughout the entire day. When installing Solar panels on a flat roof, this is easily achieved. As the Solar Panels are installed onto a bracket which tilts the panel to around 30 degrees.

With most solar PV installations, all panels in a PV array connect to each other. So, if one panel gets less light than the others the whole system's performance suffers. If some shade is present for periods of the day or you're splitting panels up over east and west facing roofs, it may be worth considering micro-inverters.

Many commercial buildings have metal trapezoidal roof structures. Here the rails are secured to the ridges of a metal roof using self-tapping screws. The base of the rails has a waterproof membrane to ensure a secure weather seal. The Solar PV panels are then clamped to the rails, keeping the panels very close to the roof to minimize wind loading
