

Are solar panels a scam?

One of the first signs of a potential scam is unsolicited approaches or door-to-door sales. A reputable solar panel company does not typically use these tactics and instead is more likely to rely on referrals or marketing campaigns. As we mentioned before, another red flag is excessive discounts or too-good-to-be-true offers.

Is a free solar panel health check a scam?

We're regularly contacted by customers, who have been offered a free solar panel health check. This is a common scam.

Are 'fake' solar companies a scam?

Beware of any company asking you to make a big deposit before they have completed their installation. This is one of the most common ways 'fake' solar companies have targeted consumers - whereby they take a hefty deposit and then never turn up to carry out the installation. This is common solar scam.

How common are cold call solar panels?

See our solar panel brand reviews. This was by far the most common cold call solar panel owners told us about - 44% have been approached about this. Technical faults with solar panels are rare. Nearly seven in 10 of those in our survey have not had a fault with their system. Some have owned theirs for more than a decade.

How do I know if my solar panel is bad?

If you're concerned, contact your installer in the first instance or a recommended solar panel firm. If there is a problem with your system this will often be indicated by a fault code on the inverter. More than half of solar panel owners have had cold calls about their solar pv panels.

Do solar panels have a fault?

This was by far the most common cold call solar panel owners said they received, with 44 per cent having been approached about this. However, technical faults with solar panels are rare, with nearly seven in 10 of those surveyed saying they had not experienced a fault with their system.
