Photovoltaic power generation is based on the principle of photovoltaic effect, using solar cells to convert solar energy directly into electrical energy. Since the output of a single solar cell is very small, a large number of solar cells are connected to each other to form a solar module, the combination of solar modules is called a panel, and the combination of panels is called a solar cell array. This is done to obtain the desired power output from the photovoltaic system.

r is the yield of the solar panel given by the ratio : electrical power (in kWp) of one solar panel divided by the area of one panel. Example : the solar panel yield of a PV module of 250 Wp with an area of 1.6 m² is 15.6%. Be aware that this nominal ratio is given for standard test conditions (STC) : radiation=1000 W/m², cell temperature=25 celcius degree, Wind speed=1 m/s, AM=1.5.

However, photovoltaic power generation also has some disadvantages. First, the cost of pv power generation is relatively high, requiring a significant investment. Second, the conversion efficiency of solar panels is relatively low, with only about 20% of light energy being converted into electrical energy. Finally, photovoltaic power generation ...

This is how photovoltaic solar cells work. Solar power generation there are two ways of solar power generation, one is the light-heat-electricity conversion mode, the other is the direct light-electricity conversion mode. (1) the light-heat-electricity conversion mode USES the thermal energy generated by solar radiation to generate electricity.

An off-grid solar power system is not connected to any electric grid. It consists solar panel arrays, storage batteries and inverter circuits. Grid connected systems: These solar power systems are tied with grids so that the excess required power can be accessed from the grid. They may or may not be backed by batteries.

For the generation of electricity in far flung area at reasonable price, sizing of the power supply system plays an important role.
