Who founded the St Kitts-Nevis-Anguilla Labour Party?

The 1940s saw the founding of the St Kitts-Nevis-Anguilla Labour Party (later renamed the Saint Kitts and Nevis Labour Party,or SKNLP) under Robert Llewellyn Bradshaw.

The islands of St. Kitts (168 km 2) and Nevis (93 km 2) are located in the Lesser Antilles chain of islands in the eastern Caribbean.They are separated by a channel of just over three kilometres. The islands were inhabited first by the Sibonay who arrived approximately 2000 years ago from Central America.
