Reliance Group is entering Bhutan's renewable energy sector by partnering with Druk Holding to set up 1,270 MW solar and hydroelectric projects. This initiative includes a 500 MW solar plant and a 770 MW hydro project. This will mark the largest FDI by an Indian company in Bhutan's renewable energy sector.

"We are pleased to be partnering with Reliance and together we are committed to delivering world-class clean energy projects that will benefit both India and Bhutan." In August 2024, Indian power company Tata Power partnered with Druk Green Power (DGPC) to develop the 600MW Khorlochhu hydropower project in Bhutan.

The partnership aims to focus on solar and hydropower projects and is considered the largest foreign direct investment (FDI) in Bhutan's green energy sector by an Indian company. Fostering Renewable Energy Infrastructure. The partnership between Reliance Group and DHI is set to bolster Bhutan's renewable energy infrastructure significantly.
