Is solar photography a good idea?

Solar photography is a very interesting, easy and affordable experience. A cheap white light filter on a superzoom bridge camera is all you need to peak into the sun's secrets. The greatest thing about solar photography is that the Sun is up there during the daytime hours.

Where can I find information about solar imaging?

In researching the topic of solar imaging, there are two sources that are particularly worth mentioning. First there is the Solarchat forum. This is a forum purely dedicated to anything related to observing the sun. Information on equipment, technical discussions, but also many, many observations and images being shared.

Do you need a tripod for solar photography?

Solar filter aside, there are few accessories you may want to consider when taking photos of the Sun. While not necessary, a tripod will improve the quality of your solar photography. With medium telephoto lenses, you can get a good 'casual' shoot of the Sun handheld. But with longer lenses or when shooting for image stacking, the tripod is a must.

How to take a good solar photo?

Try to make it as detailed as possible. If no spots are visible, zoom on the solar disk edge and aim to make it as sharp as possible. Solar filter aside, there are few accessories you may want to consider when taking photos of the Sun. While not necessary, a tripod will improve the quality of your solar photography.

Should I buy a solar filter for my camera?

Instead, invest in a solar filter for cameras. Do not look at the sun through your optical viewfinder or star finder. Never look at it with binoculars or telescope without having the solar filter firmly in place. Never use scratched or damaged filters, even if the damage is small. Inspect your filter before each observation or photography session.

What is sun photography?

Photography is all about light, and that light is often sunlight. Even at night, when you photograph the Moon and the planets, you are working with sunlight. For photography, Strauss uses a few attachments to take the place of a standard camera lens on his Sony Alpha 7 III. He uses a T-ring and a "nosepiece" and a 2x barlow lens that are the same diameter as a standard telescope eyepiece to mount the camera to the Herschel Prism just like an astronomy eyepiece.

The video shows a mount for a small 30-watt panel, but we took the concept and completely redesigned it to work with our 100-watt panel. We also made it sturdier and improved the hinge mechanism. We now have a lightweight and compact solar mount that stores easily and sets up in just a few seconds. Here's how we did it.

There are three main types of solar eclipses: Total Solar Eclipse: During a total solar eclipse, the moon completely covers the sun, plunging the area within the moon's shadow, known as the umbra, into darkness. Inspired by observing a partial solar eclipse through a dedicated H-alpha telescope, I decided to add a solar imaging rig to the observatory. But photographing the sun is quite different from deep sky imaging. It requires ...

Your safest option is a solar filter, but the optical glass ND filter may have other uses besides solar photography. When it comes to solar filters, you have several options: filter sheet, screw-on front filter, or a solar filter that mounts between the camera and lens on an interchangeable-lens setup.

IMPORTANT: The SolarQuest mount is designed for use with solar telescopes only. Do not point any other type of optical device at the Sun. Looking directly at the Sun without verified-safe, professionally made solar filtering will cause immediate and irreversible damage to your eye (blindness!), damage to the telescope, and will be a fire risk.

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Serious solar observing and solar imaging require 50mm of aperture, and the Lunt LS50 delivers on both. It's capable of high magnification (75-100x) and takes stunning solar images with even relatively inexpensive cameras. The scope's tuning system is also far superior to the one I've spotted being supplied with the Coronado PST that I own.

For photographing white light, which shows the solar photosphere with the sunspots, a simple DSLR is fine. However, a special "planetary camera" (a kind of webcam on steroids) will



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give better results.

For photography, that's a different thing. At work we have a LS100THa on an old CG-5 mount on a pier. I did a pretty good polar alignment at night using the polar finder, and for solar observation, I set the tracking rate to solar. This way, the Sun remains centred in the eyepiece for hours. I suppose I could refine the alignment...
