Here are some of our recommendations for avoiding solar scams: The saying "there's no such thing as a free lunch" applies when shopping for solar! If you see ads on social media or have a door-to-door salesperson stop by your home and share special programs that pay you to go solar, they're likely, not legitimate.

Are solar business leads a scam?

At best, this is someone generating leads to sell, not actual solar businesses. At worst, they're scammer trying to steal your identity. If you spot a scam, tell the Federal Trade Commission at ReportFraud.ftc.gov.

How do I know if a solar contract is a scam?

Pay attention to warranties, cancellation policies, payment schedules, and try to spot any hidden fees. Honest businesses will give you time to go over the terms of the contract, understand the agreement, and let you sign it in writing. To learn more, visit ftc.gov/solar. And if you spot a scam, tell the FTC.

What do cold callers say about solar panels?

The most common things solar panel owners told us they had been approached by cold callers about were: Trying to sell you a battery storage system was another frequent, uninvited offer. A few also reported cold callers claiming that their solar panels were being monitored, their system was a fire risk, or that their panels needed cleaning.

Solar panel scams target homeowners interested in installing solar energy systems. They involve scammers making false promises or tricking you into paying for services you'll never receive. Recently, the FTC also issued an alert to warn consumers about solar power scams, such as free solar panels or exaggerated savings.
