When did Palau launch its first solar and battery energy storage system?

Palau on June 3 launched its first solar and battery energy storage system (BESS) project on Friday. The project was made possible by Renewable company Alternergy Holdings Corp. and its subsidiary Solar Pacific Energy Corporation.

Who is launching Palau's first solar PV + battery energy storage system?

Alternergy Holdings Corp. and its subsidiary Solar Pacific Energy Corporation have inaugurated Palau's first solar PV + battery energy storage system (BESS) project, marking a significant milestone in the region.

What is the Palau solar battery project?

The Palau Solar Battery Project will be the largest such project in the Western Pacific. It will lessen Palau's imported fuel dependency, a major step towards its ambitious goal of 100%.

How will solar energy be produced in Palau?

Solar electricity will be produced by a hybrid 15.3 MWdc (13.2 MWac) solar photovoltaic (PV) plus 10.2 MWac/12.9 MWh battery energy storage system facility. Extensive safeguards to protect Palau's pristine environment SPEC did not leave any stone unturned to protect the pristine Palau ecosystem.

How much does Palau solar project cost?

In a press release from the company, it said the Palau solar project boasts a capacity of 15.3 MWp solar PV and 12.9 MWh BESS, making it one of the most significant foreign direct investments in the country. The project cost USD29 million, the venture marks a remarkable milestone for Alternergy.

The Philippines has rapidly become one of the most talked-about energy storage markets in Asia, with major power generation companies SMC Global Power and Aboitiz Power among those investing in portfolios of battery storage. The country's first-ever co-located solar and storage plant went online earlier this year.

In March 2024, PPUC acquired energy from Palau's first commercial Independent Power Producer (IPP), a solar company. This allowed them to replace two diesel generators with solar power. While a positive step towards renewable energy goals, the IPP system currently lacks battery storage, limiting its ability to maximise excess energy.

The largest solar and battery storage project in the Western Pacific has been installed in Palau, a 15.3 MW solar system combined with a 13.2 MWh battery. The US\$29 million installation will meet more than 25% of the country's electricity needs, and is now feeding power into the central grid in Babeldaob, the largest island in the Republic.

The UK's Green Nation has unveiled plans for a solar and energy storage project, aiming to contribute up to 750MW to the country's National Grid. Called Whitestone Solar Farm, the solar facility is located between Rotherham and Doncaster in South Yorkshire and is in the preliminary stages of development.
