Is South Georgia a small island?

It is a remote and inhospitable collection of islands, consisting of South Georgia and a chain of smaller islands known as the South Sandwich Islands. South Georgia is 165 kilometres (103 mi) long and 35 kilometres (22 mi) wide and is by far the largest island in the territory.

How did South Georgia & South Sandwich Island protect biodiversity?

These were subsequently implemented by the Government of South Georgia & the South Sandwich Islands to further safeguard biodiversity in the marine environment, and included extending the no-take zones where all fishing is prohibited to over 280,000 km² including areas of highly biodiverse seamounts and the deepest trench in the Southern Ocean.

Does South Georgia & South Sandwich Island have a marine protected area?

In 2017/18 the first five-year independent review of South Georgia & the South Sandwich Islands' Marine Protected Area was supported by Blue Belt. A panel of scientists, non-governmental organisations, tourism and fishing industry representatives, and the Government came together to review the effectiveness of the Marine Protected Area.

What is the ccTLD for South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands?

The Internet country code top-level domain (ccTLD) for South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands is .gs. The parts of the islands that are not permanently covered in snow or ice are part of the Scotia Sea Islands tundra ecoregion.
