St Kitts and Nevis has a well-developed telecommunications sector for a small country. The state-owned St Kitts-Nevis Cable Communications Company offers internet and fixed line telephone services. There are two main private telecommunications providers, Digicel and LIME, a prominent regional company in the Caribbean.

Grid-scale battery storage will be added to island grids in the Caribbean by technology providers Honeywell in the US Virgin Islands and Leclanché in St Kitts & Nevis. In both instances, the energy storage systems will be co-located and integrated with solar PV.

St. Kitts and Nevis will add a utility-scale solar and storage plant to meet one quarter of its electricity needs. The 35.6MW solar park and 44.2MWh battery storage facility will be built and operated by Leclanché,, a Swiss firm acting as EPC contractor.
