Is Switzerland a poor country?

Switzerland was a poor country for much of its history. Outside of the main cities (mainly Zurich), the population were mostly peasant farmers pursuing a subsistence lifestyle. Switzerland became wealthy as a consequence of the canny role it played in the wars which ravaged Europe in the 20th century.

Is Switzerland a pure democracy?

The pure form of direct democracy exists only in the Swiss cantons of Appenzell Innerrhoden and Glarus. The Swiss Confederation is a semi-direct democracy (representative democracy with strong instruments of direct democracy).
