For residential UK homes, the average solar panel size is generally between 1.6 to 1.8 meters tall and around 1 meter wide. These panels typically produce between 250 to 450 watts, with a common 350-watt panel measuring 1.7 meters by 1 meter, covering 1.7 square meters on a roof.

A 1 m² solar panel with an efficiency of 18% produces 180 Watts. 190 m² of solar panels would ideally produce 190 x 180 = 34,200 Watts = 34.2 KW. But inclined solar panels also need some spacing between them so practically you would be generating about half the power or 17.1 KW.

Solar panel inverter. The solar inverter is a key part of any solar panel system, converting electricity from DC to AC. This needs to happen before the inverter can be installed. The cost of your inverter will be included in the final quote of your solar panel system, which will approximately be between £500-£1,000,

The total size of this 1 kW solar panel array would be 5,3M². Remember that you'll need less space with more powerful solar panels to reach 1 kW of solar power. ...
